



JOB DESCRIPTION: FILM AND TELEVISION INSTRUCTOR

Organization Background:

Floretta P. Carson Visual and Performing Arts Academy (FPCVPAA), a public charter school located in the heart of Mobile, AL provides a seven- year comprehensive academic and conservatory arts program to students in grades 6-12. Established in 2023, FPC VPAA is one of the premier arts schools in Alabama, where aspiring young artists have the opportunity to refine their skills and flourish in one of 16 pre-professional arts conservatories.

Position Description:

The Film & TV Conservatory at FPC Visual and Performing Arts Academy is looking for an individual to teach a 9th grade beginning television course that focuses on live 3-camera studio production and protocols. Students will learn the basics about working in a TV control room and on the studio floor and collaborate to produce three episodes of a scripted show, including PSAs and news packages.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide planned instruction and activities for each class day.
- Follow course of study specified by Director of Film & Television Conservatory.
- Provide learning experiences to encourage maximum growth for each student.
- Select and use appropriate materials available for students and subjects assigned.
- Evaluate pupils' academic and social growth and communicate with parents and staff on the individual pupil's progress.
- Identify pupil needs and consult with other professional staff records, in assessing and helping pupils solve health, behavioral, and learning problems.
- Keep appropriate records (grading, attendance, etc.)
- Attend and participate in faculty meetings, student screenings, and other required FTV events
- Maintain professional competence through participation in in-service education activities provided by the school and/or self-selected professional growth activities.
- Maintain professional relationships with students, with colleagues, and between school and home.
